STITCHER WINS THE PEOPLE'S VOICE WEBBY IN MOBILE NEWS CATEGORY

San Francisco, Calif. – May 5, 2009 - The 13th Annual Webby Awards today announced Stitcher as the winner of the 2009 People's Voice Award in the mobile news category.
